## San Jose CERT Net Control Script

## For the WA2IBM 224.100 Repeater

History: script version 1.1, 2023/09/14 - W. Chang

Good afternoon, this is (Walter, AG6FK), Net Control Station for the SJ Community Emergency Response Team, on the WA2IBM repeater system. This repeater operates on a frequency of 224.100 MHz with a PL tone of 156.7 Hz. It is recommended you set this PL tone for both transmit and receive. (pause)

The purpose of this C.E.R.T. Net is to allow SJNCERT members throughout the City of San Jose who are also licensed Amateur Radio Operators to test their radios and practice checking into a CERT net for a public event or an actual emergency.

This net may be interrupted at any time for emergency and priority traffic. (pause)

For each transmission, please key your microphone, pause for about one second, and then begin to speak. This will ensure that your entire call sign will be heard. (pause)

For your check-in, please give your amateur radio call sign, first name, City Council district, and nearest cross-streets. State your callsign slowly, distinctly, and phonetically and then listen closely for acknowledgement. There may be unexpected doubles, so if you are not acknowledged correctly or not acknowledged at all, please check-in again to ensure you are accurately heard. If you have traffic, indicate this. You do not need to say "No traffic" if you have none.

(NET CONTROL: record each station's signal strength on a scale of 1 - 5 where 5 is strongest)

Check-ins can begin now. (pause)

(Acknowledge stations with name and suffix or name and call sign. Ask for more until there are none.)

We'll now take any guest check-ins.
